PARENT/STUDENT PROGRAMMING MATCHING FUNDS GRANT

The objective:

The purpose of this grant is to encourage individual PTA units to partner with each other to create and/or sponsor parent, student and parent/student educational programs and cross-school community building events. Additionally, we wish to encourage a stronger effort to present programming specifically geared toward parents.

The PTA Council offers these matching funds in an effort to help our member units present meaningful, high value educational programs and promote inter PTA co-operation. It is our hope that by making a larger pool of money available and increasing the potential audience outreach, we will enable our PTAs to plan and execute programs that may be too costly, or complicated for a single unit to manage. These may be of local PTA/school design, or pre-packaged programs that fit within the ideals, goals and objectives of the PTA.

The specifics: (Please note all of the following criteria must be met.)
PTAC will support programs:

- 1) in which two or more PTA units work together;
- 2) intended to offer child rearing information to parents and/or help parents and children learn together, and/or promote a spirit of community amongst students and their parents from different parts of town;
- 3) up to the level of ½ of the individual units' costs, although not to exceed a total of \$400 annually, per elementary school, \$600 annually, per middle school and \$1000 annually per high school from PTAC (note: this amount can be changed based on the amount of money in the budget annually); and
- 4) that are shown to be in keeping with the goals and mission of National, State and Fairfield PTA.
